7	to Christopher T. Lyons, Plaintiff's counsel. If there is an offset, any remainder shall be made
8	payable to Plaintiff, based on the Department of the Treasury's Offset Program and standard
9	practices, and the check shall be mailed to Plaintiff's counsel, Christopher T. Lyons, at Truitt &
10	Lyons, P.O. Box 1645, Coupeville, WA 98239
