16 Based upon the stipulation of the parties (Dkt. No. 21), the Equal Access to Justice Act
17 (“EAJA”), 28 U.S.C. § 2412, and the affidavit of Plaintiff’s counsel (Dkt. No. 21-1), it is hereby
18 ORDERED that Plaintiff is awarded \$6,808.93 in attorney fees, \$3.43 in expenses, and \$408.60
19 in costs, for a total of \$7,220.96. If the U.S. Department of the Treasury determines that
20 Plaintiff’s EAJA fees are not subject to any offset allowed under the Treasury Offset Program, as
21 discussed in *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586 (2010), payment of this award shall be made to
22 Plaintiff’s attorney, Rosemary B. Schurman.
