ORDER GRANTING
DEFENDANT WELLS FARGO
BANK, N.A.’S MOTION TO
DISMISS PLAINTIFFS’
COMPLAINT, DISSOLVE THE
INJUNCTION, AND RELEASE
REGISTRY FUNDS

Before the court is Defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A.’s (“Wells Fargo”) Federal Rule Civil Procedure 12(b)(6) motion to dismiss Plaintiffs Sebahat Divsar and Eraj Divsar (“the Divsars”) complaint. (Mot. (Dkt. # 9).)
