10 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable  
11 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

12 (1) On April 22, 2019, plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal, docket  
13 no. 59, purporting to dismiss its claims without prejudice. With respect to defendant  
14 Jasmine Paterson, who has not appeared in the action, plaintiff's notice will be treated as
