
ORDER DENYING
WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL

Before the court is Kirk Davis’s motion to withdraw as counsel for Defendant John Yin. (Mot. (Dkt. # 18).) Because the motion does not comply with the requirements for attorney withdrawal set forth in Local Civil Rule 83.2(b), the court DENIES the motion to withdraw without prejudice.

If withdrawal would leave a party unrepresented, the motion for withdrawal “must include the party’s address and telephone number.” Local Rules W.D. Wash. LCR

1 83.2(b)(1). The instant motion fails to comply with this requirement, as Mr. Davis's
2 withdrawal would leave Mr. Yin unrepresented, but the motion does not contain Mr.
3 Yin's telephone number. (*See generally* Mot.) The court therefore DENIES the motion
4 to withdraw (Dkt. # 18) without prejudice to refiling the motion in the manner prescribed
5 in Local Civil Rule 83.2(b).
