

3	6. Should Relators or Defendants propose that this action be dismissed, settled, or
4	otherwise discontinued, the Court will provide the States with notice and an opportunity to
5	be heard before ruling or granting its approval.
6	7. In accordance with the Maryland False Health Claims Act, Md. Code Ann., Health
7	Gen, § 2-604(a)(7), the State of Maryland having declined to intervene in this matter, all
8	claims asserted on behalf of Maryland are dismissed without prejudice.
