2 **Each Response may not exceed six (6) double-spaced pages.** Defendants may submit one
3 collective Response. The Court will take no further action in this case until the parties have
4 submitted these Responses.

5 Accordingly, the Court hereby finds and ORDERS that the parties shall file Responses
6 to this Order to Show Cause containing the detail above **no later than fourteen (14) days**
7 **from the date of this Order.**
