ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
DISBURSEMENT OF REGISTRY
FUNDS TO DARLEEN LYNN HUGHES

17 This matter comes before the Court upon notification from counsel for Darleen Lynn
18 Hughes that, contrary to the parties' previous representation that the insurance proceeds and
19 registry funds at issue in this case had already been disbursed to the appropriate parties,¹ Ms.
20 Hughes had not yet received the insurance proceeds according to the parties' settlement
21 agreement. The Court subsequently confirmed with the Clerk of the Court that, indeed, the
22 insurance proceeds at issue in this case were still being held in the registry of the Court and had
23 not yet been disbursed to Darleen Lynn Hughes in accordance with the parties' settlement
24 agreement.


25 ¹ The parties confirmed to the Court during the June 1, 2018 telephone status
26 conference, Dkt. 27, and again in their signed stipulated order of dismissal, Dkt. 26, that all
registry funds had already been disbursed to the appropriate parties. This representation was
not accurate.

1 Accordingly, the Court ORDERS as follows:

2 (1) Ms. Hughes' proposed order, Dkt. 30, which the Court construes as a Motion for
3 Disbursement of Registry Funds pursuant to LCR 67(b), is GRANTED.

4 **(2) The Clerk is authorized and directed to draw a check(s) on the funds deposited**
5 **in the registry of this Court in the principal amount of \$ 119, 347.94, plus all accrued**
6 **interest, minus any statutory users fees, payable to Darleen Lynn Hughes, and mail or**
7 **deliver the check to Ms. Hughes.**
