

ORDER DISMISSING CASE

16 This matter comes before the court *sua sponte*. Most of the defendants in this case
17 have been dismissed pursuant to the court's order granting Defendants Select Portfolio
18 Servicing, Inc. and Deutsch Bank National Trust Company's unopposed motion for
19 summary judgment. (Dismissal Order (Dkt. # 20).) The court has already determined
20 that the only remaining defendant, Northwest Trustee Services Inc. ("NWTS"), is a
21 nominal defendant. (See SMJ Order (Dkt. # 16) at 3.) Plaintiff Barbara King makes no
22 substantive or specific allegations against NWTS. (*Id.*) Ms. King, therefore, has no

1 possibility of recovering against the sole remaining defendant. Accordingly, the court
2 DISMISSES this matter with prejudice. *See Carriere v. Sears, Roebuck & Co.*, 893 F.2d
3 98, 103 (5th Cir. 1990) (A “judgment will always be appropriate in favor of a defendant
4 against whom there is no possibility of recovery.”).
