Pursuant to the Court’s September 30, 2019 Order (Doc. 42), Plaintiff Leonard A. Lemmon, and Defendant Equifax Information Services LLC (“Equifax”), by counsel, hereby provide a report regarding the status of the case.

As set forth in the parties’ September 27, 2019 Status Report (Doc. 40), the parties agreed to a nationwide settlement in *Thomas v. Equifax Info. Servs., LLC*, No. 3:18-cv-00684-MHL (E.D. Va.), which was finally approved on September 13, 2019. Subsequently, Plaintiff dismissed with prejudice all class claims asserted against Equifax in this case. (Doc. 43). The parties have engaged in good faith negotiations about whether they can reach a resolution of the remaining individual claims in the case, and respectfully request an additional two weeks to do so. The parties, therefore, respectively request that they have

1 until November 1, 2019 to notify the Court as to whether they have reached a resolution of
2 those remaining individual claims, or alternatively will propose a scheduling order to govern
3 the remaining deadlines in the case. A proposed order is submitted herewith for the Court's
4 consideration.


