12 Stipulated/Admissibility Disputed,” “Authenticity Disputed,” and “Admitted.” The latter  
13 column is for the Clerk’s convenience and shall remain blank, but the parties shall  
14 indicate the status of an exhibit’s authenticity and admissibility by placing an “X” in the  
15 appropriate column.

16 (3) All other terms and conditions, and all dates and deadlines not inconsistent  
17 herewith, contained in the Minute Order Setting Trial Date and Related Dates, docket  
18 no. 16, as amended by the Minute Order entered September 5, 2018, docket no. 53, shall  
19 remain in full force and effect.
