**ORDER REVERSING AND
REMANDING COMMISSIONER'S
FINAL DECISION**

13 The parties, through their respective counsel, stipulate that the Commissioner's final
14 decision should be reversed and remanded in accordance with sentence four of 42 U.S.C. §
15 405(g) and that upon remand, the Administrative Law Judge will conduct a de novo hearing and
16 further evaluate the opinion evidence; further evaluate the claimant's maximum residual
17 functional capacity; and issue a new decision. Dkt. 13. The parties also stipulate that, upon
18 proper application, Plaintiff shall be eligible for attorneys' fees under the Equal Access to Justice
19 Act, 24 U.S.C. § 2412 et seq. *Id.*

20 Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Commissioner's final decision shall be
21 **REVERSED AND REMANDED** in accordance with sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).
22 Upon remand, the Administrative Law Judge will conduct a de novo hearing and further evaluate
23 the opinion evidence; further evaluate the claimant's maximum residual functional capacity; and
