

Court with enough time to address dispositive motions prior to the trial date. Furthermore, the Court's existing schedule separates the close of discovery and the dispositive motion deadline by 30 days in order to permit discovery issues to be resolved before the filing of dispositive motions; the parties' proposed dates do not allow for this. Having reviewed the relevant briefing and the remainder of the record, the Court hereby finds and ORDERS that the parties' Stipulated Motion (Dkt. #18) is DENIED. The current deadlines remain in place. Nothing in this Order precludes the parties from seeking the above relief in addition to an extension of the trial date. DATED this 12th day of July 2018.
