
ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

16 On January 12, 2018, the court issued an order dismissing Plaintiff Matthew James  
17 Lindsey, Esq.'s<sup>1</sup> complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B). (*See* Order (Dkt.  
18 # 5).) The court granted Mr. Lindsey leave to file an amended complaint within 14 days  
19 that corrected the deficiencies in his complaint. (*Id.* at 6.) The court warned Mr. Lindsey  
20 that if he failed to timely comply with the court's order to file an amended complaint, the

1 court would dismiss his complaint without leave to amend. (*Id.*) More than 14 days has  
2 passed since the court issued its January 12, 2018, order. Mr. Lindsey has failed to file  
3 an amended complaint. (*See generally* Dkt.) Accordingly, the court DISMISSES Mr.  
4 Lindsey's complaint without prejudice and without leave to amend.
