This matter comes before the Court on Defendant's motion to vacate the trial date and unexpired pretrial deadlines and requesting a status conference (Dkt. No. 71). As the Court stated in its recent letter, it is important to maintain existing case schedules to the greatest extent possible. (Dkt. No. 80 at 1.) With that in mind, the Court DENIES Defendant's request to vacate the unexpired pretrial deadlines in this case.¹ Maintaining those deadlines will allow this case to proceed to trial as quickly as possible once the COVID-19 crisis has passed. The Court also DENIES Defendant's request to set a status conference, which is premature given the uncertainty around when civil trials might resume. For the sake of clarity, the Court officially VACATES the
