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15 This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff Christopher Miller's Motion for  
16 Authorization of Attorney Fees Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b). Dkt. #23. Defendant  
17 Commissioner of Social Security does not oppose Plaintiff's motion. Dkt. #25.

18 Having reviewed Plaintiff's motion and supporting declaration, the Court finds good  
19 cause for entry of this Order. It is therefore ORDERED that pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b)  
20 reasonable fees in the amount of \$7,838.93 are awarded to Plaintiff's attorney D. James Tree and  
21 Plaintiff is due an offset of \$4,825.84 for previously paid EAJA fees, leaving a net attorney fee  
22 due to Mr. Tree in the amount of \$3,013.09.
