MINUTE ORDER

The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable John C. Coughenour, United States District Judge:

Petitioner has filed a motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 to vacate, set aside, or correct his sentence (Dkt. No. 1). After a preliminary review of the motion, the court hereby ORDERS that:

(1) If not previously accomplished, electronic posting of this order and petition shall effect service upon the United States Attorney, copies of the 2255 motion and of all documents in support thereof.

(2) Within **thirty (30) days** after such service, the United States shall file and serve an Answer in accordance with Rule 5 of the Rules Governing Section 2255 Cases in United States District Courts. As part of such Answer, the United States should state its position as to whether an evidentiary hearing is necessary, whether there is any issue as to abuse or delay under Rule 9, and whether petitioner’s motion is barred by the statute of limitations.
