7	are citizens); see also GBForefront, L.P. v. Forefront Mgmt. Group, LLC, 888 F.3d 29,
5	37-41 (3d Cir. 2018) (distinguishing between a traditional trust, the citizenship of which
6	is based on the citizenship of each trustee, and a business trust, the citizenship of which
O	is based on the citizenship of each constituent owner, member, or beneficiary (citing <i>Americold Realty Trust v. Conagra Foods, Inc.</i> , 136 S. Ct. 1012 (2016))). In addition, in
7	its amended corporate disclosure statement, NP162, LLC shall (i) describe the structure
0	of the IRAs listed as members of SRP 2016-E, LLC, and (ii) identify the law under which
8	the IRAs are authorized to act and/or capable of acting as members of an LLC. Absent a timely and satisfactory response to this Minute Order, the Court will consider imposing
9	appropriate sanctions.
