MINUTE ORDER

16 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
17 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

18 (1) Counsel having telephonically advised the Court that this matter has settled
19 in principle, and pursuant to the agreement of all parties, the Court ORDERS as follows:

20 (a) Defendant Qwest Corporation's motion to dismiss, docket no. 21,
21 and defendants DIRECTV's and DIRECTV, LLC's motion to compel arbitration
22 or alternatively dismiss for lack of standing, docket no. 22, are STRICKEN
23 without prejudice to refile in the event that the parties are unable to perfect their
settlement;

(b) The deadlines for conducting a Rule 26(f) conference, exchanging
initial disclosures, and filing a Joint Status Report are STRICKEN; and

(c) Any motion for preliminary approval of a class action settlement
shall be filed on or before October 11, 2018.
