16 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable John C.  
17 Coughenour, United States District Judge:

18 This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' motion for extension of time to file its  
19 response to Defendants' motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 14.) Plaintiffs' counsel asks the Court for a  
20 one-week extension to file his response because of the complexity of the issues presented, recent  
21 unavailability, and medical problems affecting his work. (*Id.* at 1–2.) Pursuant to Federal Rule of  
22 Civil Procedure 6(b), the Court finds good cause to GRANT Plaintiffs' motion for extension of  
23 time (Dkt. No. 14.) Plaintiffs must file their response to Defendants' motion to dismiss no later  
24 than May 29, 2018. Defendants shall file their reply no later than June 4, 2018. The Clerk is  
25 DIRECTED to re-note Defendants' motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 11) to June 4, 2018.
