After a preliminary review of the 14 motion, the Court ORDERS as follows: 15 (1) Within forty-five (45) days after the filing of Petitioner's § 2255 Motion, 16 the United States shall file and serve an Answer in accordance with Rule 5 of the Rules 17 Governing Section 2255 Cases in United States District Courts. As part of its Answer, the United States shall state its position as to whether an evidentiary hearing is 18 necessary, whether any discovery is necessary, whether there is any issue as to abuse or 19 delay under Rule 9, and whether Petitioner's motion is barred by the statute of 20 limitations. 21 (2) On the face of its Answer, the United States shall note this matter for the 22 fourth Friday following the filing of its Answer, and the Clerk shall note the matter on 23 the Court's docket accordingly.
