15 The following MINUTE ORDER is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
16 Ricardo S. Martinez, Chief United States District Judge:

17 On July 8, 2019, Petitioner sent a third letter requesting reconsideration. Dkt. #28.
18 Petitioner's letter presents nothing new and merely pleads with the Court to reverse course
19 without any legal basis. *Id.* Plaintiff's repeated requests for reconsideration lack a basis in the
20 rules and, as the Court has repeatedly noted, are untimely. Dkts. #25 and #27. Accordingly, the
21 Court STRIKES Petitioner's third letter request for reconsideration (Dkt. #28) as procedurally
