case, civil or criminal, except by leave of court. . . . Leave shall be obtained by filing a motion or a stipulation and proposed order for withdrawal." LCR 83.2(b)(1). LCR 83.2 also provides

that attorneys "will ordinarily be permitted to withdraw until sixty days before the discovery cut off date in a civil case." *Id.* The discovery deadline in this matter is May 26, 2020. Dkt. #30. The withdrawal will not leave Defendants unrepresented.

Having reviewed the record in these proceedings and the Motion, the Court hereby finds and ORDERS that:

- The Motion to Withdraw as Counsel for Defendants Alexander Ohashi and Ace Parking Management, Inc (Dkt. #31) is GRANTED. Ms. Diane H. Cornell and Betts, Patterson & Mines, P.S. may withdraw from this matter and no longer represent Defendant as of the date this Order is entered.
- 2. Defendants remain represented by Ms. Laura E. Kruse and her new firm, Forsberg & Umlauf PS.
