16 Thomas S. Zilly, United States District Judge:

17 (1) Defendants' Motion for Entry of Judgment, docket no. 26, which Plaintiff
18 has not opposed, is GRANTED in part. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure
19 58(d), the Court will enter in a separate document a judgment regarding Defendants'
20 entitlement to attorney's fees as described in the Court's November 11, 2018, Minute
21 Order, docket no. 24. Defendants' request for a separate judgment regarding the Court's
22 October 17, 2018, Order granting Defendants' motion to dismiss, docket no. 16, is
23 DENIED. Due to Plaintiff's filing of a notice of appeal, docket no. 20, from the
dismissal order, the Court lacks jurisdiction over that aspect of the case. *See Griggs v.*
Provident Consumer Discount Co., 459 U.S. 56, 58 (1982) ("The filing of a notice of
appeal is an event of jurisdictional significance—it confers jurisdiction on the court of

1 appeals and divests the district court of its control over those aspects of the case involved
2 in the appeal.”).
