13 The following Minute Order is made at the direction of the Court, the Hon. Mary Alice  
14 Theiler, United States Magistrate Judge:

15 Plaintiff submitted an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* (IFP). (Dkt. 1.) He  
16 indicates he has no income, no sources of money, no cash on hand or money in checking or  
17 savings accounts, and no interest in any property. He lists zero expenses, identified as: "Section  
18 8, public transportation" and failed to sign the IFP portion of the form. (*Id.* at 2.) The Court is  
19 unable to consider plaintiff's application. Plaintiff must provide complete and detailed  
20 information as to his financial status and, if plaintiff has no means of support, he must explain  
21 how he is able to meet basic monthly expenses, including food and shelter. He must sign and  
22 date both the IFP and Written Consent for Payment of Costs portions of the form. Plaintiff is  
23 directed to submit a revised IFP application within **twenty (20) days** of the date of this Minute
