Provident Consumer Discount Co., 459 U.S. 56, 58 (1982) ("The filing 18 of a notice of appeal is an event of jurisdictional significance—it confers jurisdiction on the court of appeals and divests the district court of its control over 19 those aspects of the case involved in the appeal"). 20 Even if the Court retained jurisdiction over Plaintiff's motion, the (b) Court previously denied Plaintiff's oral request to freeze the Fisher Trust assets 21 during a hearing on Wednesday, February 27, 2019. Plaintiff's motion is therefore 22
