16 This matter comes before the Court upon Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 50)
17 and Supplemental Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. No. 51). Having read the Response (Dkt. No. 53)
18 and the related record and for the reasons stated on the record (Dkt. No. 54) the Court GRANTS
19 the Motions in part and DENIES the Motions in part as follows:
