Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e)(2). Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(e)(2). The parties have not,
however, addressed these factors in their stipulated motion to dismiss and for final
approval of their proposed class settlement in this matter. (*See* Mot. (Dkt. # 656).)
