**ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION
TO AMEND**

13 Before the Court is Plaintiffs' motion to amend. Dkt. 12. Under Fed.R.Civ.P. 15(a), a
14 party may, as a matter of right, amend its complaint once before the filing of a "responsive
15 pleading" or the entry of final judgment following dismissal of its action. *See* WRIGHT AND
16 MILLER, FEDERAL PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE: CIVIL § 1483 (1971). Plaintiffs' original
17 complaint has not yet been served.

18 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' motion to file an amended complaint (Dkt.
19 12) is **GRANTED**; Plaintiffs shall file their amended complaint within twenty (20) days of this
20 Order.
