14 Plaintiff's *in forma pauperis* (IFP) application, Dkt. 1, is deficient. She does not provide

16 to money on hand or in accounts, and indicates no income or sources of money, no property, and
17 no monthly expenses. Plaintiff must submit a revised, signed IFP application within **twenty (20)**
18 **days** of the date of this Order. She must provide complete and detailed financial information
19 and, if she has no means of support, explain how she is able to meet basic expenses, including
20 food and shelter. Failure to comply may result in denial of IFP and/or dismissal.
