

[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' EX PARTE MOTION TO FILE OVER-LENGTH EX PARTE MOTION FOR ALTERNATIVE SERVICE

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the *Ex Parte* Motion by Plaintiffs Amazon.com, Inc., Amazon.com Services LLC, and King Technology, Inc. (collectively, "Plaintiffs") for leave to file an over-length *ex parte* motion for alternative service (the "Motion"), pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7(f). Dkt. 33. The Court, having considered Plaintiffs' Motion and finding good cause, **GRANTS** Plaintiffs leave to file a motion for alternative service not to exceed 3,700 words.
