MINUTE ORDER

16 The following Minute Order is made by direction of the Court, the Honorable
17 Jamal N. Whitehead, United States District Judge:

18 On November 7, 2023, the parties filed a stipulated motion to hold the case in
19 abeyance while they attempted to resolve the dispute without judicial intervention.
20 “[T]he power to stay proceedings is incidental to the power inherent in every court
21 to control the disposition of the causes on its docket with economy of time and effort
22 for itself, for counsel, and for litigants.” *Landis v. N. Am. Co.*, 299 U.S. 248, 254
23 (1936). The Court GRANTS the parties’ stipulated motion and holds the case in

1 abeyance until April 10, 2024. The Court ORDERS the parties to submit a joint
2 status report by no later than April 10, 2024.
