(Dkt. #319) Plaintiffs expect to file certain motions regarding search issues by that deadline.

- 5 2. The parties will continue to meet and confer regarding Amazon’s proposed “spam”
6 protocol for custodians Andy Jassy and Jeff Bezos, with any motion regarding this
7 topic due no later than November 14, 2024.
