17 The parties STIPULATE and MOVE under Local Civil Rules 7(d)(1) and 10(g) to
18 remand this case to United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (“USCIS”) for
19 adjudication of Plaintiff’s N-400, Application for Naturalization. In support of this
20 motion, USCIS represents that it will schedule an interview for Plaintiff to be held by
21 February 29, 2024. USCIS further agrees to adjudicate Plaintiff’s N-400 Application
22 within ninety days of the interview date.
