ORDER DISMISSING FEDERAL
HABEAS PETITION

The Court, having reviewed Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (Dkt. # 1); the Government's return memorandum, motion to dismiss, and supporting papers (Dkt. ## 7, 8, 9, 11, 12), Petitioner's response (Dkt. # 10); and the Report and Recommendation of S. Kate Vaughan, United States Magistrate Judge (R&R) (Dkt. # 13), and the remaining record, hereby ORDERS:

(1) Petitioner did not object to the R&R. The Court agrees with the R&R's analysis and conclusions. Thus, the R&R is approved and adopted.

(2) The Government's motion to dismiss, Dkt. # 7, is GRANTED, Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus, Dkt. # 1, is DENIED, and this action is DISMISSED.
