16	waive Local Civil Rule 83.1(d)(2)'s requirement that local counsel maintain a physical

18	83.1(d)(2). The deadline to respond to the motion has passed and Defendant Hosting

20	Dkt.) Accordingly, the court exercises its discretion to rule on the motion before the

noting date. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 1 (stating that the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure should be construed "to secure the just, speedy, and inexpensive resolution of every action and proceeding"). The court has reviewed Block Mining's motion and concludes that waiver is appropriate.
