ORDER TO PROVIDE PROOF OF
SERVICE

11 Plaintiff filed this case on May 14, 2024. Dkt. No. 1. Because no activity had occurred on
12 the case since then, the Court issued an order to show cause for Plaintiff to explain by December
13 30, 2024 why the case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. Dkt. No. 3. Plaintiff timely
14 responded that Plaintiff had “duly served the U.S. Department of State with the relevant
15 documentation” but that the immigration issue had not been resolved. Dkt. No. 4 at 1. Defendants
16 have not appeared, and no proof of service has been filed. Accordingly, Plaintiff must file proof
17 of service on Defendants by January 24, 2025 or else the case will be dismissed without prejudice
18 for failure to prosecute.

20 to any party appearing pro se at said party’s last known address.
