P. 41(b); LCR 11(c). 6 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED: 7 Plaintiff is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE why this matter should not be dismissed for (1) 8 failure to prosecute (i.e., comply with the Court's Order). 9 Plaintiff's attorney of record is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE why they should not be (2) 10 sanctioned for failure to comply with the Court's Order. 11 (3) Responses to this Order SHALL be filed by February 11, 2025. 12 The Clerk SHALL renote the pending motions (Dkt.
