ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

This federal habeas action filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 has been referred to United States Magistrate Judge Grady J. Leupold. Before the Court is Petitioner’s Motion for Extension of Time to file a response to Respondents’ Motion to Dismiss and Return.<sup>1</sup> Dkt. 8. Upon review, the Court finds Petitioner has shown good cause for an extension and **GRANTS** the Motion.

The new deadline for Petitioner to file a response to the Motion to Dismiss and Return is **April 1, 2025**, and Respondents may file a reply not later than **April 8, 2025**, which is the new noting date designated for consideration of their Motion and Return.
