12 Plaintiffs have moved for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction in this  
13 cause of action alleging that Defendant, a former employee of the Jerusalem Café, has  
14 misappropriated the Farrans' trade secrets in order to open a restaurant almost identical to the  
15 Farrans' Jerusalem Café in the same geographical area, using the Farrans' trade dress and trade
