ORDER DENYING MOTION TO
PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*
AND DENYING APPLICATION FOR
COURT-APPOINTED COUNSEL

19 Plaintiffs have filed a pro se civil rights action against the above-named Jefferson County
20 Defendants (judges, prosecutors, public defender, sheriff's department personnel), and have applied
21 for court-appointed counsel and for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Having reviewed Plaintiffs'
22 Financial Affidavit and application to proceed *in forma pauperis*, as well as Plaintiffs' Complaint, the
23 Court concludes that Plaintiffs' have sufficient income to pay the filing fee in this matter and court-
24 appointed counsel will be denied.

25 ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED: Plaintiffs' Motion to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* and
26 Plaintiffs' Application For Court-Appointed Counsel are DENIED.
