Subsequently, if the prisoner's account exceeds \$10.00, each month the agency is directed to
collect and forward payments equal to 20 percent of the prisoner's preceding month's income credited to
the prisoner's account. In the event that the monthly payment would reduce the prisoner's account below
\$10.00, the agency should collect and forward only that amount which would reduce the prisoner's
account to the \$10.00 level. Please note that this \$10.00 limit does not apply to the initial partial filing fee
described above. Finally, the monthly payments should be collected and forwarded to the court until the
entire filing fee (\$350.00) for this matter has been paid.
