19	motion and established a response date of May 31, 2010. Dkt. 144. Plaintiff now seeks	
20	another sixty day extension. Dkt. 146. Defendants do not object to an extension because	
21	counsel will be out of the office for two weeks beginning May 27, 2010, however, they	
22	request that a shorter extension than that requested by Plaintiff be granted. Dkt. 147.	
23	It is <b>ORDERED</b> :	
24	(1) Plaintiff's motion for an extension (Dkt. 146) is <b>GRANTED</b> ; Plaintiff shall	
25	file his response on or before July 26, 2010.
