ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF
TIME TO RESPOND TO
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR
SUMMARY JUDGMENT


15 On March 18, 2010, Defendants filed a motion to amend their Answer to Plaintiff's
16 Amended Complaint (Dkt. 141) and a Motion for Summary Judgment (Dkt. 142). The motion
17 for summary judgment is noted for consideration on April 16, 2010. Dkt. 142. Plaintiff filed
18 a Motion and Declaration for an Enlargement of Time, requesting an additional ninety days to
19 respond to the Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment. Dkt. 143. The court granted the
20 motion and established a response date of May 31, 2010. Dkt. 144. Plaintiff now seeks
21 another sixty day extension. Dkt. 146. Defendants do not object to an extension because
22 counsel will be out of the office for two weeks beginning May 27, 2010, however, they
23 request that a shorter extension than that requested by Plaintiff be granted. Dkt. 147.

24 It is **ORDERED**:

25 (1) Plaintiff's motion for an extension (Dkt. 146) is **GRANTED**; Plaintiff shall
26 file his response **on or before July 26, 2010**.

1 (2) The Clerk shall **re-note** Defendants' motion for summary judgment (Dkt. 142)
2 for **July 30, 2010**, and send copies of this Order to Plaintiff and counsel for Defendants.
