ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO FILE OVERLENGTH
BRIEF

14 Before the court is Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Over-Length Response Brief,
15 seeking leave to file a response brief of 96 more pages than is allowed by CR 7(e)(3). Dkt.
16 109. The court previously struck Plaintiff's response and ordered Plaintiff to comply with
17 Rule 7(e)(3) (Dkt. 96) and denied a subsequent motion for leave to file an overlength response
18 of 185 pages. Dkt. 102. That denial was affirmed by the district court. Dkt. 108. In his most
19 recent motion, Mr. Curtis represents that he has endeavored to reduce his response and has
20 managed to reduce it by over half of its original length and that further reduction would result
21 in abandonment of some of his claims.

22 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

23 1. Plaintiff's motion for leave to file a response brief of an additional 96 pages
24 (Dkt. 109) is **GRANTED**.
