TO FILE RESPONSE TO
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR
SUMMARY JUDGMENT

14 Before the court is Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Defendant
15 Riley's Motion for Summary Judgment. ECF No. 152. Defendant Riley's summary
16 judgment motion was noted for January 7, 2010. ECF No. 148. Defendants have filed no
17 response to the request for an extension.

18 The Court finds that Plaintiff should be granted an extension of time to respond to the
19 pending motion for summary judgment.

20 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

21 (1) Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time (ECF No. 152) is **GRANTED**.

22 (2) Plaintiff may file his response to the motion for summary judgment (ECF No.
23 148) on or before **March 7, 2011**.


24 (3) Defendant's reply shall be due on or before **March 11, 2011**.
