In addition, counsel filed an Affidavit in support of Mr. Griffith's summary judgment 20 motion, but it is not signed by Mr. Griffith. Dkt. #70. The Court is unable to determine the merits of 21 Defendant Griffiths motion based on the record now before it. 22 Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**: 23 (1) Defendant Randall Griffith shall re-file his motion for summary judgment, with 24 appropriate exhibits and signed affidavit, and re-note his motion so that Plaintiff Ayers 25 may have an opportunity to file a response. 26 Defendant Randall Griffith's motion for summary judgment (Dkt. #69) and present noting (2) 27 date shall be **stricken** from the Court's calendar. 28 Page - 1
