14 This matter comes before the Court on the Report and Recommendation of U.S. Magistrate
15 Judge Karen L. Strombom. Dkt. 48. The Court has reviewed the Report and Recommendation,
16 Objections to the Report and Recommendation, and the remaining record.


17 On March 20, 2009, a Report and Recommendation was filed. Dkt. 48. The facts of this
18 case are set out in the Report and Recommendation and shall not be repeated here. On April 6,
19 2009, Plaintiff filed a pleading entitled "Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider and Objections of Court
20 [sic] Report and Recommendation." Dkt. 53. Plaintiff seeks reconsideration of the Report and
21 Recommendation. *Id.* In light of the fact that the Report and Recommendation has not yet been
22 adopted, the Court shall construe the arguments raised as objections to the Report and
23 Recommendation. Plaintiff's objections are without merit. Plaintiff complains that he is not an
24 attorney, and has limited access to supplies and computers. He makes no showing that the Report
25 and Recommendation should not be adopted.

- 2 (1) The Court **ADOPTS** the Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 48);
