Before the court is plaintiff's motion asking for permissive joinder of four 15 defendants (Dkt. # 14). Defendant Thatcher has responded and opposes the motion on grounds that the 16 defendant has not filed a responsive pleading to the complaint. Defendant Thatcher argues leave of court 17 is not needed (Dkt # 17). 18 Defendant Thatcher filed an answer on December 19, 2008. Thus leave of court is needed and 19 plaintiff may not simply amend the complaint as a matter of right. See, Fed. R. Civ. P 15 (a). 20 Plaintiff's motion is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff will have thirty days from the date of this order to file an 21 amended complaint naming the four new defendants and Mr. Thatcher. The amended complaint will be a 22 complete substitute for the original complaint.
