adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States and can be found on the court's website at http://www.wawd.uscourts.gov/docs. All documents filed in the above-captioned matter must comply with the Privacy Policy and the General Order.

In order to restrict access to the private and confidential information that has already made its way into the record in an expeditious manner, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to seal the complaint (Dkt. 1). Plaintiffs are directed to promptly review the complaint to ensure that it does not contain additional information that should have been redacted. Plaintiffs shall make every effort to avoid such public disclosures of confidential information in the future.

As a result of the improper filings, a substantial portion of the record is now sealed, which is inconsistent with the public's right of access. Plaintiffs are therefore **ORDERED** to file, within ten days of the date of this order, redacted copies of the complaint, which has been sealed in this case.
